

## **Status TP-SEE on the 27<sup>th</sup> of June 2005**

During an internal interservice meeting of the Commission Services on the 23<sup>rd</sup> of June the proposal for the establishment of a European Platform on Sustainable Electromagnetic Environments was discussed. The formal request to the European Commission was sent in a letter dated the 30<sup>th</sup> of May, that was update on the 9<sup>th</sup> of June with respect to the supporting letters received from various parties. Furthermore on the 22<sup>nd</sup> of June two additional documents were sent to the Commission, i.e.:

- the status report dated June 2005
- the response drafted by the Core Group on the set of criteria for the establishment of European Technology Platform.

On the 27<sup>th</sup> of June the following response was received from Thierry Brefort:

**The issue is being taken very seriously, and some of the existing platforms (Nanotech, medical equipment) have EMC as a major component, and thus would favourably see an EMC TP. There seem to be however a willingness not to expand the number of TPs. As the message "do not fragment" has been very well understood, the chairman of the interservice group has taken the initiative to elaborate an internal paper to be approved at RTD DG level on how to integrate and recognise TPs of horizontal nature. So, up to now, no green light, but we seek a solution that could accomodate Commission's willingness of limiting the number of TPs and the recognition of the SEE TP.**
